INTER-SCHOOL SWIMMING MEET 2018

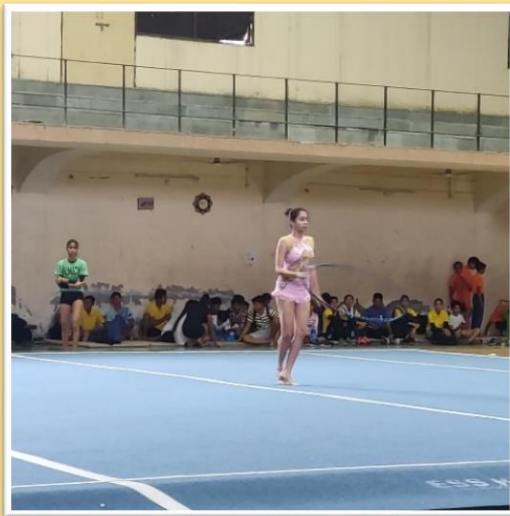
