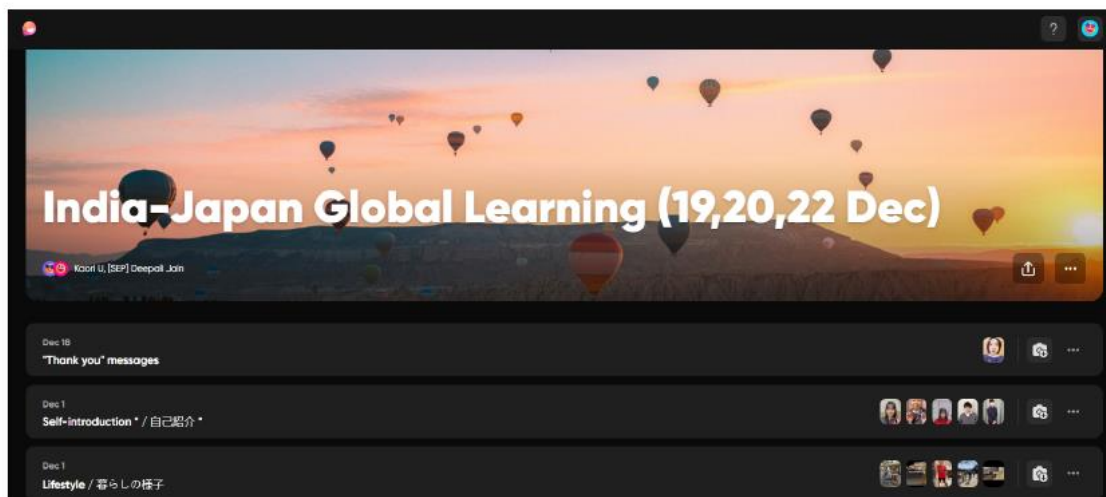


SHIN GLOBAL COLLABORATIVE LEARNING PROGRAMME
