The main filter comprises a series of metal plates and an ionizer wire. As the air particles pass through the wire, they become charged and get attracted to the stainless steel collection plates. ESP technology can capture particles smaller than 0.3 microns. The school has also imparted training to the electrical maintenance staff regarding the working of purifiers.
